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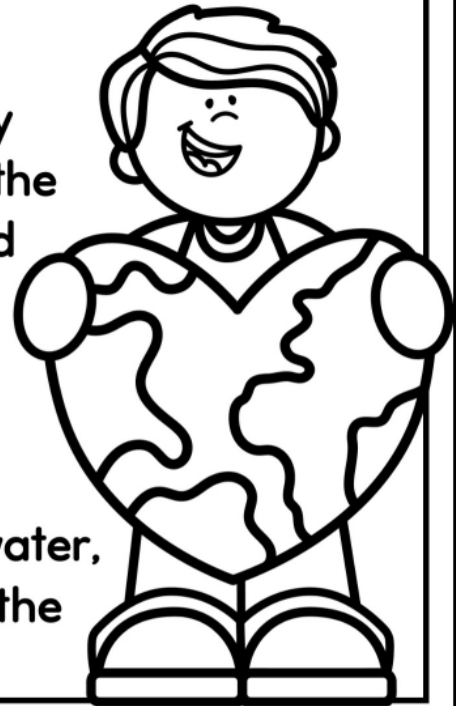
Earth Day

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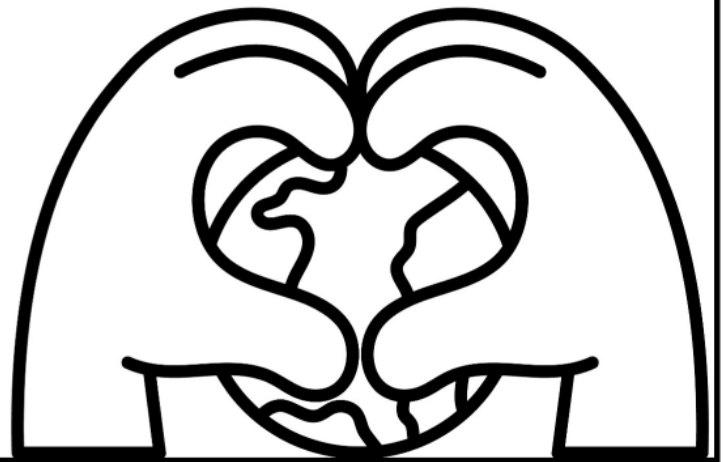
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What is Earth Day?

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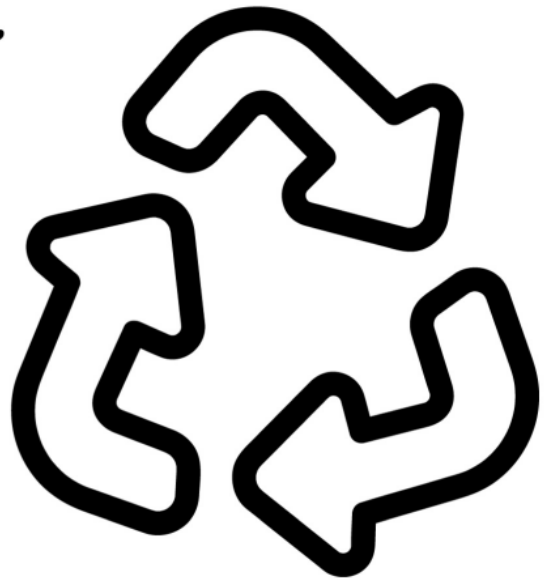
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Reuse: Use it Again

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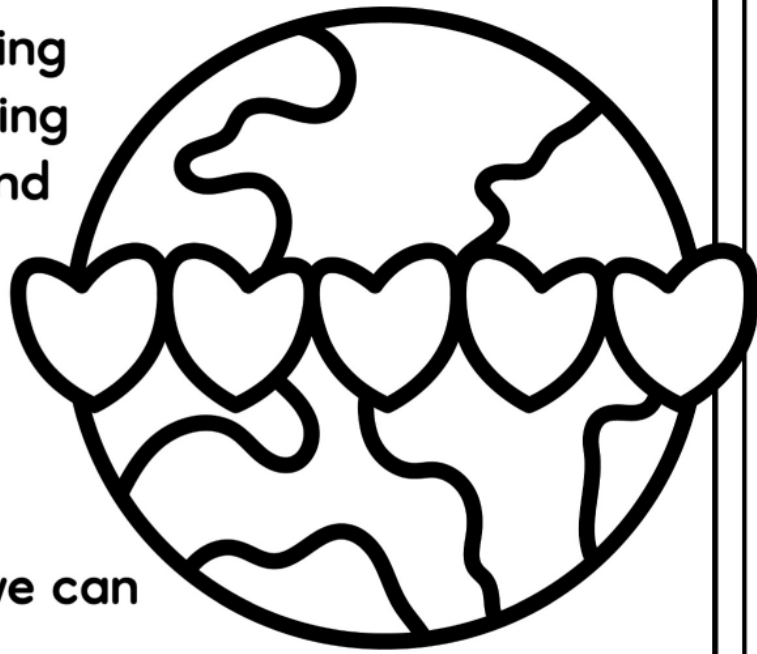
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Reclaim: Care for Earth

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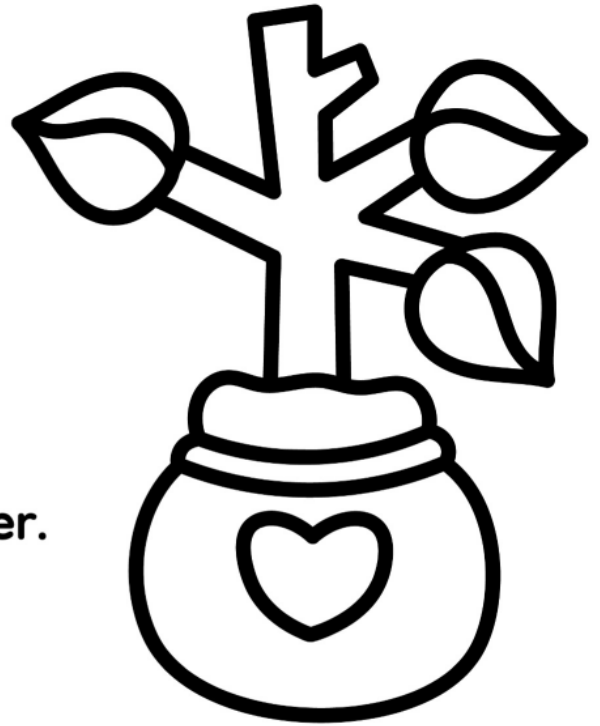
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Plant a Tree

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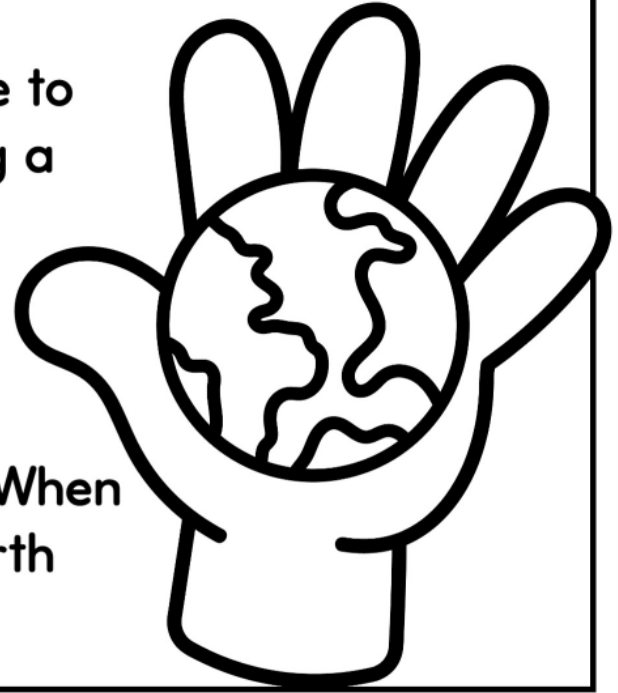
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How to Help the Earth
